



BLUE CROSS OF IDAHO IS MAKING HEALTHCARE MORE AFFORDABLE WITH \$0 COPAYMENTS FOR CHILDREN'S OFFICE VISITS.

We believe that parents should have access to more-affordable healthcare for their children. One of our newest benefits aims to do just that. Many of our members will now pay no out-of-pocket copay when they take their covered dependent children to the doctor. Better yet, this benefit comes at no extra cost to employers or members.

Expanding access to care with this \$0 copay for children's office visits is part of our mission to make healthcare more affordable for all Idahoans.

Effective January 1, 2020, this benefit is included with:

- Fully insured, medium and large employer groups (50 or more employees)
- Individual Access plan members

What's covered under this benefit:

- Visits to both primary care providers (PCPs) – such as family care providers, pediatricians, nurse practitioners or physician assistants – and specialists
- Visits for covered dependent children age 17 and younger
- Many screenings and vaccinations that take place during office visits

Note: Behavioral health visits are not covered under this benefit. However, both children and adults who are members of fully insured, medium and large employer groups can access virtual behavioral healthcare through our partner MDLIVE for a \$10 copay.
